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Shreelata has worked extensively with the World Bank and other international organizations on the development, supervision and evaluation of large scale health projects, including in Karnataka, Orissa, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu (among others). She has also worked with many NGOs to support the implementation of interventions under National Aids Control Program and in Management of Primary Health Centers.

As member of the Karnataka Knowledge Commission (since 2009), she has contributed to the development and writing of the Karnataka Health Status Report (November 2010) and will continue to be involved in the development of strategies to implement these recommendations. She is an associate of the Swasthya Karnataka Consortium.
